Department: Street Department

Job Title: Maintenance Worker/Sanitation Loader

Reports to: Street Supervisor

Classification: Hourly, Non-Exempt

Nature of Work:

Performs varied types of manual work, which may include unskilled and moderately skilled duties, minor equipment operation and truck driving.

Examples of Job Activities:

Lift and move supplies, dig and clean trenches, collect rubbish, or other refuse, cut grass and underbrush, trim trees, use shovel to remove soil or snow, sweep streets, clean storm drains, load debris, lay storm drain pipes, assist in pouring concrete, pavement repair, assist in mechanical snow removal and chemical application, and drive refuse or dump truck. Lift and load commercial and residential garbage, collect rubbish, junk or other refuse and any other duties that the Supervisor so directs.

Minimum Education, Experience, and Licenses:

Prefer a high school or GED Graduate and valid license to drive in the State of Virginia. CDL license considered a plus.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

Ability to read, write, understand and communicate in English sufficiently to perform job duties. Ability to operate minor construction equipment such as backhoe, end loader, pavement roller, refuse truck and dump truck, etc.

Physical Standards:

Have the ability to perform manual tasks such as shoveling, digging, lifting, mowing, carrying, and tasks characteristic to manual labor.

Background investigation and requirements:

Applicant will be subjected to a physical examination, drug screening and criminal background investigation.

Work Standards:

Work environment is outdoors that will include varying temperatures and climatic conditions.
